Scholarship Guidelines

- 1) Each year, up to four scholarship awards will be available for college-matriculated students from Yankee Farm Credit stockholders' farm family units.
- 2) Each scholarship will be for \$2,000. Preference will be given to applicants who have not previously received the award and who are enrolled in a degree related to agriculture.
- 3) Applicants shall be enrolled in college programs leading to a Bachelor or Associate degree.
- 4) Scholarships will be awarded on merit including academic, agricultural, civic accomplishment and essay content.
- 5) Applications will be submitted to the President of Yankee Farm Credit with the following:
 - a) a cover letter;
 - b) a brief biography; and
 - c) an essay, the subject of which is "Why I wish to pursue a career in my selected major."
- 6) Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the Membership/Governance Committee of the Board of Directors. The Membership/Governance Committee will determine the scholarship recipients.
- 7) Applications must be received by August 1st each year and will be awarded at the first meeting of the Membership/Governance Committee following that deadline.
- 8) Immediate family members of Yankee Farm Credit Employees and Directors are not eligible for scholarship consideration.
